PROGRAM OVERVIEW

In 2017, the global installation of renewable power capacity hit a new all-time record high and \$1 in every \$5 invested in the US was targeted at sustainable investments. With global developments such as the recent Paris Climate Accord and increasing demand from governments for clean, secure and sustainable energy, equipping managers with a sound background in environmental leadership has never been more important.

The Environmental Leadership Program will provide emerging managers with an overview of current sustainability trends, the tools to improve their company's environmental performance and an understanding of the commercial opportunities arising from this growing field. Course content is suitable for use in all industries.

LEARNING FORMAT

The program is usually delivered over a six month period with approximately 1.5 days a month tutorials

- Each unit is introduced through a **one day masterclass**, delivered by a tutor with extensive industry and academic experience.
- Online Learning through the Global E-Learning Portal (participants have access to the portal for 6 months from the date of registration.
- Assessment comprising a 2000-3000 word assignment per unit.
- Tutor Support is available through email, web conferencing and phone, throughout your program.
- All learners have automatic membership of the ILM for six months from the date of enrollment.
